A Message from Ed Flavin, President

First I would like to thank everyone that has donated to our Kitchen Fund. It's helping us more than you know. We still have a ways to go so please help us if you haven't yet.

Our Annual Softball Tournament at Turner Camp is just a few weeks away. September 7th and 8th. This event helps us financially but it takes volunteers to make it successful. So please sign up down at the club or call the club to let us know when you are available. Set-up, cooking, serving, clean up or even a couple of hours can make a difference.

In September we will have a Meat Raffle and Membership Drive. At this event, and only at this event, if you sponsor a candidate for membership, and they are accepted, you will get your 2014 dues at 50% off when the new member pays a prorated 2013 dues, purchases three coupon books for 2013 and pays next year's dues prior to the January board meeting. If you get two applicants, you don't pay any dues for 2014. Coupon books are not included in this offer.

We had several motions from the floor to raise the late fee for dues. The following motion was passed during the July meeting however since it is a constitution change, it will need to be studied and approved at three consecutive membership meetings to take effect: All membership dues received by our January membership meeting will not incur a late fee. All membership dues paid after the January membership meeting and received no later than our February membership meeting will be assessed a \$15.00 late fee. All membership dues paid the February membership meeting and received no later than our March membership meeting will be assessed a \$30.00 late fee. Anyone that has not paid their membership dues by the March membership meeting will be dropped from membership and if they want to rejoin, will have to satisfy all financial obligations and waiting periods as set forth in the constitution. Any member that is financially unable to pay their dues on time has the right to make a formal written request to the executive board for special payment consideration. We as Turner members must be more considerate and take on our responsibilities seriously.

Next a big thanks to Doug Anderson, Scott Lorenze, and Dave Ash for the work they did on the automobile station and truck rental building. Scrapping is just about done. Priming, caulking and painting needs to be done and we sure could use some more help. Please contact Doug Anderson or Seth or myself at 847-890-5505 if you can help. Please show your Turner support. 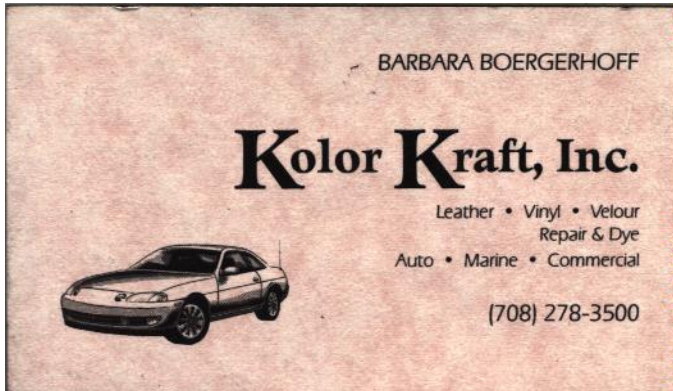
